A Message From

Nothing has prepared me other than God's will be done as I type this message. Let me begin by letting you all know how much I care for all of you and that my heart goes out to

you. I pray that I'm typing this message in a way that is clear. There was confusion on how I communicated after mass last weekend as I spoke of the committee. The committee is the teams of people from each of the parishes in our two circles. Each parish in the circle has one member on the committee. Deacon Dennis Knudsen represents St. Peter's, Kevin Connot represents St. Joseph's and Paula Wendte represents St. Patrick's. I give thanks to God for these people serving on the committee. I also serve on both committees. We spent hours creating a mass schedule that will be effective come July 2023.

Our parish teams of St. Peter's, St. Joseph's and St. Patrick's did not make the decisions for the mass schedule. This has been announced earlier but to clarify, St. Patrick's will have a Sunday Mass this July at 9:15 a.m. (Again this came from the circle of parishes that St. Patrick's is part of). This circle moved a little faster and was able to announce quicker than the circle with St. Josephs and St. Peters. With that being said, come this July, St. Peter's will no longer have a weekend mass. St. Joseph's will have a Sunday mass of 8:00 a.m. I want to stress again this came from the committee of all the parishes and priests in that circle. This was not decided upon by St. Joseph's and St. Peter's alone and the same is true for St. Patrick's. Please see the insert in the bulletin this weekend for more details. I want to stress this does not mean in any way that St. Peter's is closing. I will be meeting with the finance committee, maintenance committee, cemetery board, and sodality for St. Peter's to decide how we will go forward with no Sunday Mass. St. Peter's will have the Holy Day Masses through out the year and St. Joseph's will no longer have Holy Day Masses. Please keep all of this in your prayers. Nothing will be finalized on this until the archbishop has approved.

I have spent a lot of time working directly with the archdiocese to create a series of prayers that will lead us through our Advent and the changes that are coming.

Advent Prayer Series

As we continue down the path of the Journey of Faith, the whole Archdiocese is pausing during the month of December to prepare and await the coming of our Savior Jesus Christ. The Lord placed a desire on my heart to lead an Advent prayer series to ask Him for the graces of:

Healing and trust in God.

Understanding and wisdom from God about what it means to belong to a Family of Parishes.

Each week we will gather in the church for a short time of catechesis on prayer and then adoration with a holy hour. During the holy hour I will lead prayer with scripture and questions to ponder with the Lord.

Please try and come to these prayer times. After each prayer session I will be available as long as needed to hear confessions. There will be three sessions rotating back and forth between St. Joseph's and St. Peter's. Those dates are December 1st at St. Joseph's, December 15th at St. Peter's and December 23rd at St. Joseph's all at 7:00 p.m. and lasting approximately ninety minutes. There will also be three session at St. Patrick's and they will be November 26th, December 3rd, and December 10th all at 10:00 a.m. These sessions will last approximately ninety minutes as well. Please bring something to write with. If there is bad weather and we have to cancel any of these sessions we will send a message out via Flock Note. Please have a friend you can call if you do not have Flock Note to see if we had to cancel due to weather.

I want to wish your family a very Happy Thanksgiving. We do have so much to be thankful for. Please note we will have one Thanksgiving mass on November 23rd at 7:30 p.m. at St. Joseph's church. Feel free to bring items for your Thanksgiving table you would like to bless. You can leave it by the altar and I will bless the items before the final blessing. There will be no mass on the 24th and 25th of November. I pray you have a wonderful week. Please pray for me and please know in my prayers you remain.


